### WHY SHOULD WE HAVE A NATURAL RESPECT FOR CREATION?

The ark in the Noah story became the image of the church and the image of salvation. Notice that God doesn't have Noah take only his wife and his children into the ark. He also has him take two of every animal. Now what is that saying? Apparently, that animals matter! That the animals also needed to be saved and to be liberated, and therefore were a part of the divine ecology, a part of the divine plan. Still, many animals on this earth have been nothing but beasts of burden for our use and misuse, and hunting pleasure.

We must recognize that on the Ark of Life are not just the humans and the animals. We must go beyond the animals and rediscover respect for every part of creation, which includes the plants and the trees and the bushes and the flowers and even the movement of the air by which you and I have lived every single moment of our lives. Spirituality is almost another name for ecology, and ecology is almost another name for spirituality.

## Corpus Christi Building Debt

Although our Sanctuary-Plaza construction is completed, it is not paid for, as we still owe money for our Bank Loan. This weekly financial status is meant to identify our outstanding Building Debt, our income from Building Fund contributions, profit from Gift Card (Scrip) sales, and our Capital Campaign pledge payments. Any donation shortfall to our Bank Loan payment will need to be taken from our financial reserves. Each month we should see some reduction to our Building Debt amount.

<b>Shortfall</b>	<b>\$ (12,720.45)</b>

At this point, we will have to use \$ 12,720.45 from our Building Fund Reserves to make the mortgage payment. We have **this** weekend to reduce our shortfall.
