

# **Corpus Christi Hiking Club** June - October 2013

# Sunday, June 2 - Sycamore Reservoir Trail #39

*4.4 miles, easy* This hike starts from the Gordon Hirabayashi Recreation Site just over 7 miles up the General Hitchcock Highway and ends at Sycamore Reservoir.

#### Sunday, June 23 - Dutch John Trail #91

*3.6 miles, easy* This pleasant trail leads from Bog Springs Campground to a cool, grassy area of seeps and springs tucked away in a small canyon on the slopes of Mt. Wrightson. There will be a pot-luck picnic following the hike. All are invited.

# Sunday, June 30 - Miller Canyon Trail #106

*7 miles, moderate* A fine riparian area, plenty of evidence of the area's mining past and good views from the Huachuca Crest are some of the rewards you'll reap along this trail.

#### Sunday July 14 - Salisbury Trail

**4.6 miles, moderate** A hike to Salisbury Saddle to the highest point in the Chiricahua Wilderness. The trail heads northeast and ambles up through a lovely forest of oak, Apache and Chiricahua pine, and Arizona cypress.

# Sunday, July 28 - Crystal Springs Trail #17

*5 miles, moderate* Staged hike from Soldier Camp through Crystal Spring to the Mt. Lemmon Fire Road.

#### Sunday, August 4 - Gardner Canyon

*6 miles, moderate* The trail ascends the eastern slopes of the Santa Ritas passing through country that is virtually deserted when compared to popular Madera Canyon on the mountain's western slopes.

## Sunday, August 18 - Ladybug Trail #329

**5.9 miles, moderate** A staged hike in the Pinaleños. The upper trailhead is located in stands of mixed conifers from which the setting changes gradually to oak woodland and eventually to manzanita and desert scrub as the trail drops into Jacobson Canyon at its lower end.

#### Saturday, September 14 - Box Canyon Trail

7 *miles, moderate* A hike in the high grass lands off Route 83 before you get to Sonoita.

#### Saturday, September 28 - Arivaipa Canyon

*11 miles, easy* A hike in the wet wilderness of Aravaipa Canyon about 35 miles southeast of Globe.

# Saturday, October 12 - West Fork Oak Creek #108

*6.8 miles, easy* A wonderful, picturesque hike along a flowing creek in Oak Creek Canyon, Sedona.

#### Sunday, October 13 - Huckaby Trail

5.8, easy An lovely hike along Oak Creek outside of Sedona.

## Sunday, October 27 - Cochise Stronghold Trail #279

*9.5 miles, moderate* Located in the Dragoon Mountains, this historic Indian trail connects the west and east canyons of Cochise's Stronghold.
