

Hello and welcome to Corpus Christi's Confirmation Program.

Our Corpus Christi Youth and Confirmation Groups have been active and even thriving during recent challenging times! We meet up daily in Zoom with outreach, exercise, guided meditation, positive life skills, liturgy and Bible study and more! We have also started a flex inperson program and will continue online as long as needed! We will continue to keep the group updated as we adapt and adjust accordingly. Confirmation candidates will be participating in these Zoom meets as well as in-person activities, as a way to continue their service portion of the preparation for the Sacrament

As we begin to meet in person, we will focus on hands-on service and guest speakers. At this time we are continuing Children's Church on Zoom at 11 am on Sundays, and Confirmation candidates are encouraged to assist. Sacrament prep will follow, either in-person or on Zoom. Outside of the Sunday classes, there are a few other meet-up times as allowed: a moonlight labyrinth walk; serving at the Stations of the Cross/soup suppers on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of Lent; Guided meditations on Friday nights; Zoom workout and outreach projects, attending the Triduum liturgies during Holy Week; and leading the Stations on Good Friday at noon.

I lead the Confirmation classes and Youth Group with a fantastic support team of volunteer leaders. I began at Corpus Christi when my son was in second grade. I helped with the religious education and First Communion class, and then taught my son's group all the way up to 5th grade. At that time, I began to lead the Children's Liturgy of the Word on Sundays and then, about 9 years ago, I was asked to be the Coordinator of Youth Ministries and preparing the teens for the sacrament of Confirmation. I have also prepared youth for other Sacraments (Baptism/First Communion/Reconciliation) at Corpus Christi. Our Youth Group continues yearround. We are planning more retreats up to visit Mary Undoer of Knots Shrine at Mt Lemmon, Equine Sanctuary in Tubac, Pima Animal Care Center and more. We typically have many off-campus volunteer missions to animal shelters and rescues and sanctuaries and well as volunteering at an Equine Therapy program for Angels in Autism.

Each teen must make this Confirmation commitment on their own and throughout this course we will be challenging their faith, their values, and their beliefs. We encourage them to ask questions and actively participate in discussions about their faith. We welcome the opportunity to support the evolution of the teens, their spirituality, and this next step of Confirmation.

CONFIRMATION: AM I READY?

This is the question that will be answered through the preparation classes. This is the reason for the preparation classes. We want to give you a chance to make that decision for yourself. **YOU HAVE TO MAKE IT FOR YOURSELF!!** No one else can receive the gift that God is offering **YOU** through this Sacrament. If you find you are not ready to receive this gift, no big deal. At least you know what it is all about now. And God will always offer the gift again, and again, and again... Do not be ashamed if you do not feel you are ready. It takes a lot of courage to admit it, but everything will be OK if you decide to put it off a year, or two, or more. Just to be sure we are not wasting your time from the start though, here are some general recommendations for those looking to start the preparation process.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CANDIDATES

Be mature enough to handle discussions on morals, ethics, God, the Holy Spirit, Jesus, miracles, fears, disappointments, relationships, world events, etc.

Have an interest in being an active Catholic and learning about different ways to be active/involved in our community.

Have enough interest in your Church, your faith, and your beliefs to have questions about them.

Be willing to help your community through service.

Be willing to actively search for a sponsor <u>outside of your immediate family</u> who is an active Catholic, who you can respect, who you can go to with spiritual questions, and who you see as a guide on your spiritual journey.



COVID-19 Waiver, Release, and Assumption of Risk Form

COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. The new Delta variant is proving to be even more contagious and is affecting our youth and younger population. Although [Parish] has implemented protective measures to reduce the chance of spread of COVID-19, we cannot guarantee that your child(ren) will not become infected while participating in inperson learning and other parish-sanctioned activities.

On behalf of myself, my household members, and my minor child(ren) identified below, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and specifically assume all risks and hazards associated with my child(ren)'s in-person religious education attendance during the COVID-19 pandemic. I acknowledge that by attending class in person, my child(ren) will be associating with staff and other children and may acquire COVID-19 notwithstanding any precautions taken by the parish. I acknowledge that the parish cannot absolutely control the conduct of its students, guarantee that they or their parents will follow recommended safety protocols and procedures, or prevent infected students from attending and potentially spreading COVID-19 to my child(ren), directly or indirectly.

I further acknowledge that my child(ren)'s physical attendance at [Parish] is voluntary and that I have the option to pursue other educational programs through other providers. By permitting my child(ren) to attend [Parish] during the COVID-19 pandemic, I voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) may acquire COVID-19, and that COVID-19 may subsequently be transmitted from my child(ren) to me and members of my household. I understand that symptoms of COVID-19 include, but are not limited to, fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

I certify that my child(ren) currently has/have none of these symptoms, and I will prevent my child(ren) from physically attending parish religious education if they develop any of these symptoms or any other symptoms identified by the CDC as being associated with COVID-19. My child(ren) and I will also follow all COVID-19 protocols and procedures adopted by the parish.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, I hereby agree to waive, release, and discharge any and all claims, causes of action, damages, and rights of any kind against the parish, the school, the diocese, its insurers, and all of their respective employees, agents, representatives, and volunteers (the "Released Parties") arising from or relating in any way to any damage, injury, trauma, illness, loss, disability, dismemberment, or death that may occur to my child(ren), me, or my household members as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. I further agree not to sue the Released Parties, and to defend and indemnify the Released Parties for all claims, damages, losses, or expenses, including attorneys' fees, if a suit is filed concerning an injury, illness, or death to me, my child(ren), or my household members as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
