

From the Desk of Fr. Chris



Flesh vs. Spirit. This theme is peppered throughout Paul's letters, and he takes it up again in the second reading. Too often it's taken as a battle between the physical and the transcendental, but for Paul it goes to the core of our trust and hope. Whenever he uses the term "flesh" he's referencing human power, human ability, and human authority. It's a view that I am the center of the universe and the measure of all things and can do it all on my own. The "Spirit" recognizes that there is One greater than ourselves and that we cannot save ourselves. Life in the Spirit is a life lived from God, for God, and always in relationship with God. The past three weeks the Woman at the Well, the Man Born Blind, and Martha today are all presented with the question, "Do you believe?" Paul would probably be a little more specific – "In whom do you believe? In whom do you place your trust and hope?"

Holy Week Mission "Here's Hoping..." April 14, 15, 16

Are you so involved scurrying around with business, children, family, social activities etc., that you have little time for quiet contemplation with God? A parish mission is a time of special grace when God calls us into a deeper relationship with Him, a time for personal growth, a time to listen to God, a time for spiritual refreshment and renewal.

Join twin brothers Fr. Bob Gielow and Fr. Dick Gielow each evening at 6pm in Church as we begin Holy Week. There will be a special mass with a homily from the twins designed for a Lenten Renewal. A reception will follow each evening to enhance our community life. (*April 16 session will flow into individual Penance.)

The twins have been conducting parish missions for more than 40 years and have celebrated over 50 years of priesthood. They have ministered as principal of high school, director of campus ministry, director of athletics and retreat master. They have advanced degrees in Philosophy, Theology, Religious Education, Counseling, Divinity, Religious Studies and Pastoral Studies. Their ministry has offered them experiences all over the world. They don't always conduct parish missions together, so this is something special.

They were born in LaSalle, Ill. And are members of the Congregation of the Mission (Vincentians) founded by St. Vincent De Paul. Fr. Dick lives in Leawood, Kansas and Fr. Bob lives in Lemont, Ill. They have one sister, Mary Ann who lives in Tucson and is a member of Corpus Christi.



"Keep Watch with Me" Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament SIGN UP FOR HOLY THURSDAY ADORATION

At **Holy Thursday** mass, we remember the Last Supper that Jesus shared with his disciples. And then Jesus asked them to keep watch with him in the garden before he is taken by the soldiers to be crucified.

On Holy Thursday, the priest consecrates not only the bread for that mass, but enough for Good Friday as well. The bread for Friday is taken to the Community Center after mass for adoration until midnight and then held in reserve until the Good Friday service. Come watch with Jesus. You can spend any amount of time with him after Holy Thursday mass, thus entering more deeply into the Triduum, the holiest days of the church year.

According to the Congregation for Divine Worship, "It is an invitation to silent and prolonged adoration of the wondrous sacrament instituted by Christ on this day."


To assure that all times are covered, please sign up in the narthex until the Wednesday, before Holy Thursday. If all slots are filled, you may just come at your preferred time.

Religious Education the Family Way Family Faith Formation

This month the children who are preparing for their First Communion have been focusing on the Sacrament of Reconciliation, more commonly referred to as Confession. While I've heard some Catholics express gratefulness in regards to this sacrament, most of us avoid it. Who wants to look deeply into their faults? We try to justify our actions or forget them, but that doesn't always work especially when we may hang onto the thought that it's up to us to earn acceptance.

Admitting fault might feel like we're admitting that we aren't worthy. But Jesus taught and showed that God's love is not dependent on our actions. Confession gives us an opportunity to feel that forgiveness, to hear out loud that we are forgiven, and to stop believing that we don't belong.

Even without the sacrament, it's still important to reflect on the times when we could have done better, and pray for guidance. We will never be without sin, but through forgiveness we can live more humbly and love more deeply.

If you are planning to trim your palm trees this spring, we have a need for your greenest fronds to decorate the altar.




