The Pastor's Musings—

Dear People of God of Corpus Christi Parish,

(continuation from last week's article)

Of particular importance in establishing the importance that the **word of God** has for the **Church** is the **Ambo**. This should normally be fixed & not simply a movable lectern. The material & design of the **Ambo** should themselves point to the **permanence** & **beauty of God's saving word**.

"The dignity of the ambo requires that only a minister of the word should make use of it. The Ambo is used exclusively for the proclamation of God's word in the Scriptures, including the singing of the responsorial psalm; the elucidation and application of the word in the Homily and general intercessions; and also the Easter proclamation (Exsultet)."

--Celebrating the Mass 98

In the same way that the **Liturgy of the Word** & the **Liturgy of the Eucharist** are so closely related as to make up **one act of worship**, so it is appropriate that there be **an evident relationship between the Ambo & the Altar**. Sometimes this is achieved through their being made from the same materials, sometimes from a sharing of other aspects of design. However, they should not look the same, for they have different functions.

Whenever you walk into a **Catholic church**, one of the first things to catch your attention is the **Altar**. Within our Catholic liturgical tradition, the Altar takes "*center stage*" & has the place of prominence within the sanctuary.

The liturgical documents of the **Second Vatican Council** remind us that the Altar should be placed & constructed that it is always seen to be the **sign of Christ Himself**, the place at which the saving mysteries are carried out, & the **center of the assembly**, to which the greatest reverence is due.
