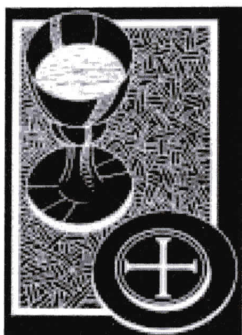

Serving the Body of Christ ...



The Eucharist is the heart and center of the Catholic Christian experience. It is a gift to be given and received. The ritual interaction between the giver and receiver is an expression of the communion that lies at the heart of the church's identity.

An ordinary minister of the Eucharist is ordained, that is, the bishop, priest, or deacon. An extraordinary minister of the Eucharist is a baptized and confirmed, practicing Catholic who can put reverence into practice by helping the ordained minister distribute the Body and Blood of Christ.

Eucharistic Ministers are members of the parish trained to assist in the distribution of the consecrated Body and Blood of Christ. Their ministry helps the whole community by making it possible for the Communion Rite to take place in a length of time that is not out of proportion to the overall liturgy.

... to the Body of Christ

Pope Paul VI described the people involved in this ministry saying: *"The faithful who are special ministers of communion must be persons whose good qualities of Christian life, faith, and morals recommend them. Let them strive to be worthy of this great office, foster their own devotion to the Eucharist, and show an example to the rest of the faithful by their own devotion and reverence to the most august sacrament of the altar."*

The commitment that comes along with being a Eucharistic Minister is to serve at scheduled masses, in which one would already be participating. If unable to minister at an assigned Mass, the minister is responsible for making timely substitutions with another qualified Eucharistic Minister.
