what is Youth Group?

We use a comprehensive model of youth ministry.

It boils down to three main points: faith, fellowship, and service. The goal is also three fold:

- 1) To empower young people to live as Disciples of Jesus Christ in our world today
- 2) To draw young people to responsible participation in the life, mission, and work of the Catholic faith community
- 3) To foster the total personal and spiritual growth of each young person

Through out the course of the year we use many resources and activities to attain a comprehensive ministry. There are 8 more finite themes that we address through out the year with all the teens. Some of the themes we focus on more heavily with different age groups. The National Conference of Catholic Bishops set forth these eight components for us:

- 1)Advocacy: use our values, voices, and votes to shape a society that prioritizes and protects the children. We build up their self esteem and advocate for them and teach them to be advocates for their values.
- 2) Catechesis: passes on the faith (scripture, tradition, values, teachings) of the Catholic Church
- 3) Community Life: We build an environment of love, support, appreciation and acceptance where meaningful relationships nurture a Catholic life
- 4) Evangelization: The energizing core of ministry which is rooted in and proclaims the Good News, inviting teens into a deeper relationship with Jesus
- 5) Justice and Service: Develop a social conscience and commitment to a life of justice and service as modeled by Jesus.
- 6) Leadership Development: Calls forth, affirms, and empowers the many gifts, talents, and abilities of teens
- 7) Pastoral Care: Compassionate life skills of relationship building, assertiveness, nonviolent conflict resolution decision making and planning
- 8) Prayer and Worship: Celebrates and deepens teen's relationship with Jesus.
