Lastly, they distribute bulletins, prepare the Narthex for planned baptisms and return the church to its prior condition.

#### **Schedule**

Four Ushers serve at the 4:30 pm Mass on Saturday and at the 9:45 am Mass on Sunday. Each serves four consecutive weeks and is the Usher-in-Charge on his/her fourth week of rotation.

Two Ushers serve the 7:45 am Mass on Sunday each calendar month.

An overview of the Ushers' duties is in the Ministry statement. A Lead Usher watches over each Mass.

If an Usher is unable to serve as scheduled, we ask that he or she use our Roster to seek a replacement or advise the Lead Usher for that Mass.
